This is beta version! It has not been tested.

Changes:

- o Dragging items in the schedule caused a crash.
- o Changed the password encoding to use the operating system services.
- o The MAPI connection to Outlook is closed when the calendar is disabled.
- o Added optional app indicator icon for Linux.
- o Rainlendar_ShowMenu() required that submenu was wrapped inside a table.
- o The week for the past dates was calculated from the start of the week insted from the end of it.
- o Some menu items were twice in the task editor.
- o The calendar must be selected in the new calendar wizard before proceeding.
- o Deleting a single instance from a recurring event caused duplicate exception days to be created into Google calendar.

First, this isn't a bug, but it's a thing that annoys me sometimes.

If I have two Shadow4.r2skin files (one from app folder and the other user folder) then Rainlendar loads the newest one. Maybe the one from user folder could not be updated, but it could have addons installed.

I had to change the date from one of them after compare if inner files needs to be updated, and then refresh.

Maybe loading first the one from user folder isn't the best solution.

Not sure if merging could replace edited files.

What about some kind of sign? Something like "There is a new version of Shadow4/Chromopore/Savannah skin. Do you want to update it? (You will have to reinstall addons)"

Hi senior_spielbergo,

I was having the same problem and was able to solve it by installing libappindicator from the AUR. I've already suggested to add the new dependency to rainlendar-beta-unstable's depends on the corresponding AUR page.

EDIT: If you run into problems installing the package (as I did) due to a problem with different perl versions (5.14 vs 5.16), try moving /usr/lib/perl5/site_perl to another place.

I have "WARNING" in rainlendar2.log

The error means that there are exception days (e.g. deleted instances of a recurring events) in the feed but the original event is missing. I'm not really sure what could have caused this.

The change means that instead of encoding the passwords with a proprietary algorithm Rainlendar now uses the operating system's crypto library to do it. So, it's more secure.

You actually shouldn't see those assert dialogs. I'll have to check why they are still visible.

1. this bug is on russian locale. when i open 'settings', 2 error windows are up.

The error is in the translation. Some of the different English texts are translated into the same Russian text which causes the problem with the grid control. I would appreciate if someone who understands Russian would go through the advanced page in the options and fix the duplicate texts in it.

2. this bug is found in english locale. all categories are shown as circle signs on calendar.

Did you enter the categories in Russian? If you change the language Rainlendar cannot match the category names anymore so you'll just get the default category icon. You can enable Options->Advanced->"Store English category names" if you need to use different language versions.
