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Welcome to the forum, Morten.

If you're using the Lite version, isn't possible.  
Using the Pro version, you can access a shared network calendar using webcal protocol.

Remember to try before you buy! You can install and test the Pro version before you make the decision. The Pro version is fully functional even without the license except that events from network, Outlook and Google calendars will have string in front of them.
