Changes:

- o Shortcut keys in the message dialog buttons didn't work.
- o The manager sometimes crashed when viewing tasks that were in in progress state.
- o Filtering in manager's search worked only for the summary field instead all fields.
- o Adding new subtasks to Google calendar was not working.
- o It's possible to define every second saturday of the month as the weekend day.
- o The sorting of the event list can be reversed.
- o All text can be selected in the description editor with ctrl+a.
- o The digiclock in Shadow4 can have a title text.
- o Added screenshots to the help.

I have OS X Mountain Lion. There is no option to remove the icon from the Dock. I tried every possible way to remove the icon from the Dock, but it is still there. Additionally, when I try to change the "Time Format" into "%#l:%M %p (e.g. "3:42 pm")," the application still displays time in the EVENTS window with the "0," i.e., "03:42 pm". Finally, the tray icon should be a little bit bigger. I have Macbook Air 11" and it is really hard to see the date from a normal viewing distance. Please address these three issues in the following releases. Thanks for your consideration!

Welcome to the forum, Ashton.

To remove the tray icon: right click on a window -> options... -> skins -> advanced>>> -> in the "active skins" (right) click on trayicon -> click on the left arrow -> click ok.

The help file says: You can use the #-flag to remove the leading zeros (e.g. %#d). This works only in Windows though. So it doesn't work for OS X.

I support adding feature for manager search in the free text area. Possibly a checkbox on the manager screen 'Search in Description' or better still in the advanced configuration area.

BTW if the description field is not shown in manager anymore does this mean manager doesn't load that text area at all (therefore no search capability), or more of a user convenience option?

If so, I suggest a 'mouse over' the item opens the description field, again - configurable on/off in the advanced setup.

This bug affect also in a new profile with only 1 event in the default calendar. Changing "number of past days the list shows" not only not show past events, but add the number of days to the "future days".

This is an example:  
Today is 2/11  
Event on 2/9 (2 days before)  
Event on 3/1 (18 days after)  
Event on 3/2 (19 days after)  
Number of past days showed: 12  
Number of future days showed: 6

Result:  
Event list only shows the event on 3/1.
