Recurring evens are great. But sometimes you want to have a recurring event on every first Sunday of the month unless that Sunday is on the 1st (or maybe the 1st, 2nd or 3rd, etc) of the month. Same goes for last Thursday of the month, maybe you don't want the event if said Thursday is on the 31st.

Additionally, it would also be handy to be able to create a recurring event each time a specific day falls on a specific date. Every Tuesday the 7th for instance.

All just examples but hopefully it's understandable what i'm looking for.

You can set a daily recurrence, repeat it every 17 days (number of days between 2/26/2013 and 3/15/2013) and repeat only 1 time.
