The only comparable option is "Show Tray Icon", which seems useless on a Mac and, in any case, has no effect.

I am using version 2.11 b128 32-bit. Thanks in advance for any help you can give.

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You can still hide the dock icon in Rainlendar but you need to edit the configuration files manually. In `~/rainlendar2/rainlendar2.ini` file change the "ShowDockIcon" to 0 and in `/Applications/Rainlendar2-Pro.app/Contents/Info.plist` change the LSUIElement's value to true. Note that this will at least disable the main menu since OS X doesn't allow agent applications to have one. There might also be other issues which I'm not aware of.

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Since I'm the person who started this thread, I thought that I'd reply. Like you, I came to the Mac from Windows and the Rainlendar icon initially drove me crazy. In time, and after using a Mac for a while, I think you'll change your mind; but I absolutely understand where you are coming from. The best thing is to experiment a bit and find what suits you best.

The "LSUIElement" value should be the last one in your info.plist file. It's there; you don't have to create it. What app are you using to edit your .plist file (that might explain why you can't find it)? Apple's Xcode is the best, but UltraEdit also works fine.
