It might be a problem with the size of the elements. I see to reduce the size of the font or to increase the distance between characters (although I prefer the first one).

EDIT: I duplicate the size for the characters and upload the skin into deviantART. Now you should see the W.

What I don't understand is why the characters are so close together. I can see the dots of Ä are in the previous line... I suppose the font is the same... so...
