Dear Developers,

I have a Pro BETA (to sync with Google Calendar) 2.11 b125 (32bit Windows)

When I create a repeating event (with a stop-end time) and by mistake move it from one day to another the repetition goes away.

This is rather bothering for weekly meetings that get cancelled now and then and are not taking place during holidays. I do all the "fixing" of the event

And then one day I move the weekly meeting from Thursday to Friday and ALL The effort is gone. I have a lone Friday event and all my "fixing" is gone from Google as well as rainledar2.

It seems really easy to reproduce: Even a 3 repetitions event on Thursday with start 15 and end 16 is moved to Friday and I have a lone event on Friday 15-16!

I hope you can find a fix for this rather annoying error.

Moving a single instance of an event should just create an exception for the original event and not destroy it. It seems to work correctly with native Rainlendar's events but not with Google's events. I'll see what is causing the problem.
