
Category field lost functionality

The Category field in the Event editor dialog of version 2.11 seems to have lost some functionality compared to a previous version of Rainlendar (2.9, I think).

In 2.9, when you enter the category field and start typing a few letters, it automatically fills in the matching category, along with colour and icon. Pressing Enter would close the dialog and accept the changes.

Now in 2.11, it does not autocomplete the category, or show the icon, and hitting Enter while the cursor is in the field does nothing. It also doesn't work properly in the tab order. If you activate the field using the mouse, hitting Tab takes you to the previously active field, not the next in the chain.

The tab seems to focus the alarm controls after the category control. It's probably because the alarm controls are created dynamically so they go to the end of the tab order. I'll see if that can be fixed.

Hello. I can't get this to work, in either build 128 or 137. Could there be a conflict with with system hotkeys/shortcuts? I'm on Vista.

I noticed that the hint (in French) from the task & event windows File menu says Ctrl-Entrée (Enter), and not Ctrl+Entrée/Enter like you wrote. Would there be a difference??? :huh:

(Strangely, in my mind, I used to be able to do this, but I'm really not sure since I have to use the mouse for the time, etc.)

That is the case. In English, Ctrl+Enter works fine. And it solved, BTW, another bug: when going in the manager (in French), Show Actual would crash Rainlendar. Even got in a loophole (by creating a new calendar in the options with the manager opened I think) where I couldn't even open the manager without crashing. Updating did not solve it, but switching the interface to English did the trick, after having restored the system.
