
Rainlendar beta; network error on startup

Hello. I am new to Rainlendar but am moving along pretty happily with it so far.

One issue that maybe someone here can help with.

Here is my setup, then the problem.

Macbook Air w/ Mountain Lion

Rainlendar Beta 2.11

Rainlendar is syncing with Remember The Milk. No other calendar in use.

I have Rainlendar set up to auto-start when I turn my system on

That last point there is where my issue arises. On this system, because I have RL starting at system startup, it appears to be starting and trying to poll Remember The Milk before my system is actually logged in and connected to the Internet. For that reason, I am getting an error (I didn't write it down but can if necessary) that is obviously related to the network connection. If I prevent it from starting at startup and then start it manually after my system has finished logging on, then there are no problems.

So...is there a setting/switch somewhere that will force RL to wait some specified amount of time before it tries to go out to do its first sync after it loads? Seems like that would do the trick.

Try this : Options > Advanced > change (increase) the values of "Network access delay after startup (ms)"
