## Wrong time format produces poison event

I have Rainlendar set to display 24-hour time (Settings > Advanced > Time Format > %#H:%M)

I goofed and added a new event using 12-hour format (e.g. 7:00 pm).

When Rainlendar tried to sync with iCloud, I got a 403 CalDav error. I would prefer to have this trapped.

The effect was a "poison" event that wouldn't sync and was generally problematic.
