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I'm not able to reproduce the problem. You should upgrade to the latest version of Rainlendar and see if it has the same problem. If it does, please run Rainlendar in the debug mode and send the debug log to me (use the support email address and include a link to this forum thread). If you have multiple calendars enabled please disable all the others so that the log will contain only the calendar which has the problem.

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The log does not contain any errors so everything seems to go just fine from Rainlendar's point of view. However Rainlendar gets only a single notification from Outlook after the deletion which would suggest that Outlook indeed does not actually delete the events.

I have no idea what could be causing this. I tried deleting multiple items from Rainlendar with Outlook 2000 and 2007 but everything works fine here.
