Has anyone got Rainlendar running with Mozilla Lightning running under Thunderbird 2.0 Beta 1?

Sunbird used to give me the option of using a .ics file instead of the built-in .sdb SQL-lite database system. If I used the .ics format I could make Rainlendar look for that file, and it worked perfectly. In Lightning there doesn't seem to be the option to force the use of a .ics file instead of the database .sdb? This means I can't open the calendar because the .sdb format isn't supported by rainlendar.

Any suggestions gratefully received! If this doesn't work then I'll have to go back to Sunbird, because I'm not giving up Rainlendar!
