From July 2012 to December 2012 , I just have to set the "Visible Month" to 7.

But from January 2013 to June 2013, I have to change this value each month to -6, -7, ...

Is there a way to have "visible month" set to July 2012 permanently ?

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The absolute "Visible Month" setting works only with positive values so it can't be used to show months from past year. You could try to use scripting to change the displayed month. Here's one which changes the start month to July 2012 once per minute.

```
function ResetToJuly_OnTimer(userData)
  Rainlendar_SetDisplayDate(1, 6, 2012)  -- Jan = 0, Feb = 1, ...
  Rainlendar_Redraw(0)
end
```

-- Create a timer which triggers once per minute

```
ResetToJuly_OnTimer(nil)
Rainlendar_CreateTimer(60 * 1000, ResetToJuly_OnTimer)
```

You can paste the code to a \*.lua file and place it in Rainlendar's scripts folder and it should work after automatically.

If you want to improve the script there is a similar one in the wiki which does things a bit better as it doesn't change the date unless necessary and works better if the display date is changed manually.
