I've got some problems with my google calendars in Rainlendar since some time.
Google didn't accept the first modification of an event (but it worked when I modified a second time).
I upgraded Rainlendar to version 2.11 (pro), and now, Google don't accept when I create an event, half the time!
The error message is:
"Unable to upload the event:xxxxxx
(0) 400 Bas Request.
Badly formatted datetime"

When I insist (creating exactly the same event), it works.

Does anybody have the same problem with Google?
