Hi,

I use rainlendar on the desktop to manage my jobs for my business, I also use it for a personal calendar in which I would like to have the regular things I do on a weekly basis (such as sports etc that are on throughout the week). However, I'd prefer these regular events not to be highlighted (make the date turn blue etc from the white that a date with no event would be). So I want a way to see at a glance that I don't have jobs but I can still for example right click the date if somebody is enquiring about a booking and then I'll be able to get reminded of the regular personal events I have so if possible, I can make the booking around these.

So is it possible at all to add an event and have it hidden from being highlighted, but not hidden when the date is right clicked? I know you can hide the event and this won't highlight it, but it won't be visible when right clicking the date, only when looking up "manager".

If you are using the skin support custom categories, you can specify (or add) a category (like Personal), then modify that category's appearance, from Options > Skins > Categories > Personal > Calendar day color > White > OK.

Sorry, I'm no explain clear. The values of priority are (example): default event is "0" categories events is "> 0"

so, if you want not to overwriting the default colour of the jobs, you can try to set as "< 0", like "-1" or more small.

Yes, when update Rainlendar or re-install Rainlendar, Shadow4 may be overwritten back to the old.

But you can go to change Shadow4's name, make it like a new skin, to avoid that. (recommend: copy it first, then change name)

Usually, Rainlendar's skins folder, on Windows system, is at: C:\Program Files\Rainlendar2\skins or go to check: (sometime will be here) Windows XP: C:\Documents and Settings\\.rainlendar2\skins Windows Vista & 7: C:\Users\\.rainlendar2\skins
