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Copy the attached file to your program's script folder (e.g. C:\Program Files\Rainlendar2\scripts). Then change the double click taskicon action with:

right click -> refresh. (IMPORTANT)

Then right click -> options... -> skins -> advanced>>> -> select "Shadow4 - Tray icon" on the right side -> settings... -> change left double click to "Minimize Toggle Windows". <http://www.rainlendar.net/cms/images/fbfiles/files/minimize.lua>
