Is it possible to put the scripts not only into the main program folder (i.e. "%ProgramFiles%/Rainlendar/scripts" on Windows), but into the user settings directory as well (i.e. "%USERPROFILE%\rainlendar2\scripts") ?

It's not easy to add/change the scripts in the main program directory - some users could not have the write permissions there, and additionally, it's better to have all user files together in one place - so, in user directory.

"%ALLUSERSPROFILE%\rainlendar2\scripts" For all users (shared)

"%USERPROFILE%\rainlendar2\scripts" For a user

os.getenv("username")
