I just switched to FC6 from Suse and i'm having trouble getting Rainlendar to run. In Suse 10.1 it ran perfectly but in fedora the iCalendarPlugin.so plugging fails to load and although the program runs it isn't fully functional.

When i ran dmesg after loading the program i see the following error (about which i am clueless).
