The file doesn't need to be copied. If you had installed Rainlendar2, you only need to double click on the file in the Windows Explorer and it will be installed automatically.

or with command line (riga di comando):

(for skin) rainlendar2.exe -i .r2skin

(for addon) rainlendar2.exe -i .r2skin-addon

To use the icons, you will need to edit / create a category and set the small / large icons.
