If you want to store the settings somewhere else you can start Rainlendar2 with `-c` command line parameter (the defines the path to the settings). [http://www.rainlendar.net/cms/index.php?option=com\\_easyfaq&Itemid=26#faq1](http://www.rainlendar.net/cms/index.php?option=com_easyfaq&Itemid=26#faq1)

Remember if you're using ics file (local files), move to this folder or select their path in the options' calendar tab.

All that was done, All files from the original folder (.rainlendar) were moved to the new one, including .ics file. Calendar's path was set up to the new folder.

Those modifications allowed to designate .ics file in the new folder as the active one. All other files (.ini) remained copies - slipping: after any modification only files in .rainlendar folder are modified, but not in the new one.

I think I found the problem. When Rainlendar2 starts on Windows, is because it add himself in the Windows Registry.

If you know how to edit the registry (take care of this):

- 
- Go to HKEY\_CURRENT\_USER\Software\Microsoft\Windows\CurrentVersion\Run
  - Update the key "Rainlendar2" with the new value (e.g., change this with your folders):  
"C:\Program Files\Rainlendar2\Rainlendar2.exe" -c="D:\DATA\rainlendar2"

Although you had created a backup folder, Windows is still loading the original user folder.
