Welcome to the forum, GrouchyGaijin.

The Window-Title is not using a string, but using a image that include title-text and background.
The code-line is :

The files of images are on (e.g. shadow4.skin) :
shadow4.skin\images\Events-bg-.png

So, you can create a new image and replace the old one.

Or, modify the code-line as :

(note, this will no background, unless to add a new background-code-line.)

Thank you for the answers.

This skin is actually called My Basic Calendar but it is probably very similar to Shadow4.

In any case, I found the bg image for the event's list and thought I'd just edit the image. So, I made a duplicate of the original png and then changed the text to Google Tasks.

Well, I had to make the font really small to fit into the image and when I refreshed R2 I had a very small Google Tasks instead of a nice looking TO DO:

So I thought I'd just increase the font size. When I did that, I also increased the canvas size to fit the text in comfortably.

I ended up with Google Taskssssssssssssssssssssss

Thank you.

I decided that the font I was using didn't look good so I changed the font to LCDMono Bold.
I had to play with the font size a bit, because with the new font, the margins that you suggested didn't work very well.

How do you know what the margins should be?
I thought maybe it is based on the png size, except the png I uploaded is 108 px wide and the margin you suggested has 105 as one of the values.

I'd like to use an image that is a bit larger for the events background, because as it is, I'm using G. Calendar instead of Google Calendar because I run out of room on the canvas.
(When I tried making the canvas larger I had display problems. Also related to the margins?)

I'm used to Conky and this xml stuff is quite a bit different than just laying everything out in simple code (example `{font}`)

I am also not very clear the usage of "margins", but after repeated attempts, I get the idea:
If image-width is "108" pixel, and string(Google Tasks)-width is "100" pixel,
when use margins="left, up, right, down"
"left" must greater than "100", smaller than "108",
"right" must smaller than "108 - 100"

I had not use Conky, so I do not know what different between them.
