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If I understand you correctly, that is what I achieve by using multiple calendars. 1) appointments, 2) for billable time (very short...), 3) misc entries (conferences etc), 4) birthdays, 5) misc days (UN-day, Groundhog day etc), 6) proper holidays (Easter, Christmas, Bank holidays etc). Based on default category displays in options, they display with different colours - or I exclude them completely (typically birthdays/misc days as they mean nothing for my planning).

To me that seems like a better way to make it work with all iCal calendars.

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If i understood you correctly, you have a couple of calenders side by side, on top of each other. 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Ooops no - I wasn't clear enough on this. Actually I use only a dual-month calendar + event-list (shows 35 days ahead). Point is that I use several calendar-FILES. All the different calendar files display in the same window. I can turn each calendar(-file) on and off from the right-click menu (or Ctrl-1, ctrl-2, ctrl-3 etc). That way I can remove eg birthdays from display easily. Or display just appointments (as they are stored in my main calendar).
