It's probably caused by some event that you have in your calendar. The beta versions have the asserts enabled so you see these from time to time. It would be useful if you can attach the event so I can try to check what exactly is the reason for the assert. If you don't know what event is causing the problem you can just click cancel and ignore the issue or go back to the official release version.
