Hi,

I'm a new pro user, running Win 8 64.

I'd like to be able to show/hide the rainlendar windows, and I've setup hotkeys for this. Unfortunately when I show the windows they don't come to the forefront of the other windows I have open. I can make them come to the front using the 'On Top' setting, but then when I try to enter a new appointment the window pops up behind the calendar and I have to move the rainlendar windows to be able to access the window.

Any suggestions as to how I can solve this? Ideal behaviour is that when I show the windows the pop to the front, and when I enter a task the window pops in front of the other rainlendar windows.

I tried this on Windows 8 and at least in my system everything works as expected. The "Show Windows" hotkey brings the windows on top of other windows. Note that you need to set the window position to "Normal" since with "On Bottom" and "On Desktop" they can't be brought on top.
