This is beta version! It has not been tested.

Install instructions for Windows:

1. Make a backup (File->Backup in Rainlendar's manager dialog)
2. Download the zip file from above
3. Uncompress the contents of the zip over your current Rainlendar installation (C:\Program Files\Rainlendar2)
4. Run Rainlendar2.exe

Changes:

- o Google calendar's color mapping showed the categories always in English
- o The manager shows and filters the snooze and dismiss times for the alarms.
- o The alarm snooze/dismiss time can be reset by clicking the alarm icon in the manager.
- o Google calendars with '#' in the url were not read correctly from the server.
- o Logging unicode characters sometimes caused a failure.
- o Changed the CalDAV to send proper etag to the server when editing the events.
- o Changing task status to in progress from the dialog did not work.
- o The task completed time can be reset by clicking the status icon in the manager.
- o Dragging items in schedule view set incorrect time if the area height was set to non-even number.
- o Tasks without status property but with completed date are shown as complete status.
- o The upcoming, cancelled and completed tasks are hidden by default in the today window.
- o The time for the tasks is now optional.

incorrect strings:

- (1) Snow only snoozed (clicking the alarm icon in the Manager)
- (2) Snow only completed (clicking the status icon in the Manager)

unable translation:

- (3) No events today (in Today window)
- (4) No tasks today (in Today window)

You can change the color mapping (one color, one category) in Options -> Calendars -> (Google calendar) -> Color mapping (in the lower panel).
This bug is visual. The color's names for selection are showed only in English even if the Rainlendar's selected language isn't English.

E.g.: "DUE;VALUE=DATE:20131003"

When trying to install this Beta, it says "access is denied" through Winrar, when I get to:

3. Uncompress the contents of the zip over your current Rainlendar installation (C:\Program Files\Rainlendar2)

Not sure where I'm going wrong here.

*I've been getting tons of errors now while trying to launch Rainlendar, although somehow along the way it seems to have recognized the new version. All of my "To Do's" are gone, although my daily events are still there.

I then tried to do a restore from the backup I made, and the errors are still displayed on launch, and my "To Do's" are still gone, even though it said the restore was successful.

WinRar probably don't have permission to write to the Program Files folder. You need to run it as administrator or extract the files first e.g. to desktop and copy them from there.

Google Tasks have been moved to a separate calendar so you need to create a new "Google Tasks"-calendar for the tasks.
