Well, there is also this same option ("Choose month") in the Rainlendar's context menu. If you want a context menu for your window, you can have something like:

No joy, though it does translate my english tooltips for 'Next month' and 'Previous month' and for 'Current month' but not for 'Current Month (right-click select month)', it also translates the event and todo list titles. :S

Rainlendar automatically translates some words/phrases if they are stored in the localizations files. "Current month" is localized but your text isn't. There isn't an extra file to add user localization. One time I talk about this with Rainy, and the (only?) solution could be detect the selected language and show the right localization by script.

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
