Install instructions for Windows:

1. Make a backup (File->Backup in Rainlendar's manager dialog)
2. Download the zip file from above
3. Uncompress the contents of the zip over your current Rainlendar installation (C:\Program Files\Rainlendar2)
4. Run Rainlendar2.exe

Changes:

- o Added next and previous buttons to the Shadow4's Grid Calendar.
- o RegisterMenuItems() lua method can be used to add new items to Rainlendar's menu.
- o Alarm should not constantly pop in front of other windows anymore if it is not set as topmost.
- o Google calendar (v3) accesses the calendars by their id instead the name.
- o It's now possible to expand and collapse the subtasks in the todo list.
- o Refresh is done automatically after successful skin/addon installation.

@Ticogrande, Ok, I found the reason for this. The change was made only for the Mac version. Previously (and still in other platforms) there was an editor for the snooze time values but it didn't work correctly in Mac so it was changed to a plain text edit. That's what caused the separator to change from comma to semicolon.
