I switched to the beta version because I had run into the issue of saving events that disappeared, but also because THIS happened. I though I had solved both issues in one swoop, I guess not!!

So, I turn on my computer and instead of Rainlendar being where it is supposed to be hanging out, in the upper right-hand corner of my screen, it has shrunk down to tiny size with the default 'skin' in the middle of my desktop and is no longer showing my google calendar info. Even when I increase the calendar size manually (to 500x500), the calendar looks different. I reloaded in my google calendar, but my events are not showing. This is horrible. I totally rely on this calendar!

I'm running windows 7.

Sounds like the Rainlendar's settings have been deleted for some reason so it reverted to the default settings. You can restore the old settings from the automatic backup files that Rainlendar creates every day.

Not sure about the Google events though. Rainlendar does not do anything to the events unless the user explicitly edits them. Does Rainlendar's manager dialog show the events? Are they visible if you log in with the browser to the Google's web calendar? Do you get any errors when the events are read? Are there any errors in Rainlendar's debug log file?
