Welcome to the forum, heisiheisi.

You can from Control_Panel > Fonts > open(click) > Typeface_Name, to see wether there is a english name.

In fact, elements.xml support the use of non-English word also.

That is, you can direct input Chinese word in elements.xml, but just, you must store(save)(encoding) elements.xml as "UTF-8 without BOM" (or called "ANSI as UTF-8") format, not as "ANSI", "GB2312" or "UTF-8" format.

Recommand you use "NotePad++" (<http://download.tuxfamily.org/notepadplus/6.5/npp.6.5.Installer.exe>), it is a editor I'm using.
