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If you are in the same network and you don't access the calendar file from two places at the same time you can just move the file to a shared folder (change the Filename in Options->Calendars). If you want to connect to the same events also from the internet you can set up e.g. a CalDAV server and connect Rainlendar with it. You can also store the events e.g. to the Google Calendar if you don't want to set up a server of your own. Note that the CalDAV and Google Calendar support are only available in the Rainlendar Pro.

Once you have set up the Google Calendar you can choose where the event is stored from the bottom left corner of the event editor. The events which you store to Google's server can be accessed from other computers too as long as you have internet connectivity.
