Here's what happens when Rainlendar tries to authenticate with the Google's server:

I've never seen the "bad access" failure before so I'm not sure what exactly is causing it but something in your system seems to block Rainlendar from connecting to the Google's IP addresses. The usual suspects are firewall or other security software which you might have installed or perhaps a hardware router which for some reason stops the traffic.

With Rainlendar v.2.11 (b129) the connection works (screenshot attached).  
Fire wall is the same, hardware is the same, roter is the same, Windows 8.1 is the same!  
And Rainlendar v. 2.12 (b134) works with Windows XP.  
Please see the last line of the log file in Sceenshot.

I tried this in Windows 8.1 and if I add Rainlendar to the Windows Firewall's block list I get the same error. So, you should verify that this does not happen in your system too. Note that v2.11 and the beta are different applications so even if the one has access to network it doesn't mean that the other one has it too.

Some security software also use reputation based blocking which is a real problem with beta versions since they are not used by very many people and hence their reputation is low. I don't know if Windows 8.1 has this kind of mechanism but at least if you are using any 3rd party security software you should check if this is what is happening in your system.
