This is beta version! It has not been tested.

Install instructions for Windows:

1. Make a backup (File->Backup in Rainlendar's manager dialog)
2. Download the zip file from above
3. Uncompress the contents of the zip over your current Rainlendar installation (C:\Program Files\Rainlendar2)
4. Run Rainlendar2.exe

Changes:

- o The status and priority filters in the manager did not work in other languages.
- o The time is now written to the template too (but only if it is changed before the template is saved).
- o The drawing order of the skin items can be defined with "zorder".
- o The opacity of the background in Shadow4 can be changed from the settings.
- o It's possible to disable the alarm sound for a individual event.
- o The calendar can be defined with the quickadd by enclosing the name in ": e.g. "Summary "
- o Added skin info caching for r2skin files which makes the options dialog open faster.
- o The today window is activated by default if the skin is selected in the simple mode.
- o The font face for the windows can be overridden in Options->Advanced->Font face
- o Fixes to the CalDAV support to make it compatible with Synology server.
- o Moving tasks as the first item in Google Tasks did not work.

I just have a problem with time. I've added a task, selecting the due date but forgot to change the time (it reads 14:30 as default). Then, I try to change it (writing) to 10:15. OK. Look in the calendar, but it still reads 14:30. But..., if I select a time from the dropdown list, it changes. Unfortunately, in this case it doesn't work for me as 10:15 isn't in the list. Of course, creating a new task with my time works fine.

The "No sound" seems to revert back to default alarm after refresh. The iCalendar parser probably skips the empty field. I'll check that.

True. The relative name doesn't give much information and if the user has changed the default alarm he should know what it now is...

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In several last builds I have a problem with Remember the Milk no due time tasks (I believe it is happening since b133). E.g. if I add task with due date set to 23.11.2013 via RTM web interface, Rainlendar indicates it as the due date has been set to 22.11. 0:00. Therefore these tasks are reminded one day sooner than they should be! When I start Rainlendar I am constantly reminded with tasks that have due date set for tomorrow.

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The asserts are shown in the beta versions always so it's not possible to turn them off. It's quite difficult to try to track down the assert related to the invalid times since you would have to find the event which is causing the problem. One way would be to move the events to a different calendar which is not synched with Rainlendar until the error does not happen anymore. This works only if the error happens always though.

Anyway, the asserts usually are not critical errors. In the main releases they are disabled so you won't see them.

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Just "for the record". I imagine these have already been reported here, but I have just recently installed the beta and probably have missed reading them in the long thread.

1. New events do not get added to the google calendar. Manual refresh seems to pick the new one up.
2. Sometimes I get error message UNABLE TO DOWNLOAD (6)0 UNABLE TO UPLOAD EVENT (0) 404 UNABLE TO DELETE (0) 404, but usually no error message even though the operation has (new, etc.) has been carried out.

Is there a way to increase the internal refresh rate as a temporary workaround?

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The 404 error means that the event doesn't exist in the server. This can happen e.g. if you first delete the event from the server and then try to do the same from Rainlendar. Using an old offline copy can also cause the 404 error. In that case it is advised to reset the offline copy by disabling it first and enabling it after a refresh.

The .rainlendar2 folder contains all the settings and locally stored events. The problem with the Google Calendar is related how Rainlendar handles the response from the Googles server so the settings do not any impact on that. If you suspect that there is some incompatibility problem with the old settings you can create a portable setup from the latest beta version.

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## 404 Error

I'm not using an "old offline copy". So I must have accidentally deleted the event from google calendar, if that is the only other known cause of the 404.

### The problem with the Google Calendar

For me the Google Calendar problem manifested itself by all new events not showing up on the other computer's rainlendar display. (We run rainlendar on two computers.) So far, after installing b135, that problem appears to be fixed.
