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You can e.g. edit the shortcut's properties and add the parameter to there.

Note that you need to start Rainlendar from the shortcut so that the correct command line argument is used. If you want to start Rainlendar automatically on startup you can move the shortcut to the Windows' Startup folder (C:\Users\\AppData\Roaming\Microsoft\Windows\Start Menu\Programs\Startup).
