Outlook 2007 supports only Webdav for dataexchange, but I haven't implemented it on my Server. At the moment I use Rainlendar with ftp-connection for one calendar and one from Outlook 2007, but I can't sync it together. I hope the full sync support for Outlook will be implemented as soon as possible.
