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I am having a similar issue with x64 Pro (v2.12.1 b137). I just upgraded from a prior version this morning.

I have created a google tasks calendar and have preserved my original google calendar.

- a.) The events from google show up on Rainlendar.
- b.) Events appear synced in my google account.
- c.) Tasks appear synced in my google account.
- d.) Tasks do not appear in Rainlendar. (ToDo list has "No tasks"
- e.) Rainlendar Manager has tasks/events as per Gmail account.
- f.) Have Google Calendar and Google Tasks calendar set to display and sync regularly.

Is there some fix to this so I can see my ToDo tasks locally? Any help would be much appreciated.

@geist88, if you can see the tasks in the manager window it can mean that you don't have any active tasks. Go to the window's settings and check that none of the "Hide \* tasks" settings are not enabled. Check also that the todo window doesn't have any include or exclude filters.
