Hello,

The snooze function desperately needs a customizable timer; it should be possible to select when a specific reminder should re-appear (something like "remind again in x minutes/hours/days"), instead of the default setting of 60 seconds. For example, I have the reminder for birthdays set to 14 days in advance - but I would also like to be reminded about seven days in advance again (depending on whether I gotta get a gift or not ;)).

I just noticed that right-clicking an alarm window allows you to set a different interval for the snooze timer (from 1 minute to 2 hours).

It'd be great if there was an additional menu item that brings up a simple input box to enter a custom number of minutes/hours/days for the snooze timer.
