You can find instructions how to edit the skins from Rainlendar's help. You need to uncompress the skin and edit the monthview.xml file. The pre- and postshowcount attributes are in the `<monthview>` element. You can find more details about the attributes from the skin reference in the help.

The category icons in Chromophore are images so you cannot change their color automatically. You can use the category editor to choose a different icons for the categories though.

Try like this:

- * Uncompress the skin
- * Open MonthView.xml with a text editor
- * Set the attribute values like this:
 - ** keptodayinplace="1"
 - ** postshowcount="-3"
 - ** preshowcount="1"
- * Compress the skin again to a zip file (make sure to compress only the skin content and not the folder they are in)
- * Rename the Chromophore.zip to ChromophoreEdited.r2skin
- * Install the edited skin and select it in Rainlendar

The skin.xml file must be at the root of the zip archive. When you open the archive there must not be any extra folder inside (compare with the existing working skins).

and, if you maximize the screenshot, you'll see that the windows in month view grow as the row goes down (the 7 Jul. window is bigger than 30th of June, 30th of June is bigger than the 23rd window, and the 23rd window is bigger than the 16th window)

I probably updated the latest version of the skin which requires the beta version. Try this instead.

You can repackage the skin like this:

- * Select all files and folders
- * Right click over the skin.xml
- * Choose Send to -> Compressed (zipped) folder
- * Rename the created "skin.zip" to ChromophoreEdited.r2skin

The changelog for the skins can be read from the Options->Skins. It's very brief though and very likely does not include all the minor changes that are made to the skin.

As far as I can tell the size of the days are same on all weeks...
