i hope my answer will be the good one
you must set the default alarm, so all the events will have an alarm (indepedently of the individual alarm you can set on each event)

to set the default alarm, you must go to the options/calendar, select the calendar you use, then in the parameter area, change the number in default alarm (positive to set after the event, negativ to set before)

i put 240 so each event get alarm at 4:00 AM the day of the event

BEGIN:VALARM
ACTION:AUDIO
TRIGGER;VALUE=DURATION:PT0S
X-RAINLENDAR-ALARM-TYPE:alert
END:VALARM

Just beforeEND:VEVENT

If You feel comfortable with sed:
