My problem may be similar. I have an event to remind me of property tax payments. The local gov allows a 4 payment plan starting end of Jan and every other month after that.

I have the calendar marked for the last weekday of the month for these payments and have the alarm set for 21 days in advance. But the alarm keeps triggering during the in between months. I've had this problem for years and figured I must be configuring it wrong.

In the pic I've hovered over the last day of the month to show the tax reminder is not there even though the alarm is triggering. The event shows correctly next month.

Reproduce BloodLust's issue:

Summary: test Sunday weekly event/task

Start/End time: 2014/4/6(yyyy/m/d), All day event

Alarm: 7 Days before the event starts.

Recurrence: any values, weeks

If weekly\_events is happen on Sunday, the alarm window will always be trigger at every 1 weeks.

Sometime can reproduce the issue, not every time.

Not yet found the rules of issue..

Found another issue:

Summary: test The last weekday event/task

Start/End time: 2014/1/31(yyyy/m/d), All day event

Alarm: 7 Days before the event starts.

Recurrence: Repeat every 3 Months, On the last Friday of the month

The alarm window has strange display.

There was a bug in handling weekly event alarms that were on Sunday. It should be fixed in the next build.

The other issue is caused by the "Hide from alarm after days"-setting. By default the alarms which are more that 7 days old get acknowledged automatically so the alarm will start to show the next alarm. I'm not sure why you see the alarm though since it should not trigger until a week from the next event. I was not able to reproduce this.

The alarm I mentioned showed up in June even though I had it set for the 21 days prior to the due of the last weekday of July. I killed the alarm in June and the alarm never came back in July so I'm guessing there is just something a bit odd in how it calculates the alarm on this every other month with varying end of month days it needs to figure out. I'm pretty sure I've tried alarms of shorter length like 14 days but still had the same behavior.

I seems found the rule of those issues :

1) tim74's issue :

The error is: events dates is recalculated every month. On single number (1,3,5,7,9,11) months, the dates is correct. But on double number (2,4,6,8,10,12) months, the dates is incorrect. (I even change system-time to test)

Example:

If create 5 events, like following images show,

you can see, at 8/1 (m/d), only the 1st event is correct.

2) my issue :

Use the above same issues.

And, add a setting :

Options >> Calendars >> Default >> Default alarm (minutes) >> 0

then, you can see that the alarm window will display strange strings for next trigger time.
