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## \ "MODIFICATION\_FAILED\" with Lightning / Rainlendar

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Hi,

I'm using the combination Rainlendar and Lightning to manage iCS based calendars. I have a problem with alerts generated by Rainlendar. Rainlendar uses the "ACTION:AUDIO" in the event. Lightning instead uses "ACTION:DISPLAY".

If the iCS calendar contains events/tasks with a reminder defined in Rainlendar (with the "ACTION:AUDIO" statement), the modification (adding/deleting/changing events) with Lightning will fail with the error message "MODIFICATION\_FAILED". The calendar can only be used as read only in Lightning in such a case.

After replacing "ACTION:AUDIO" with "ACTION:DISPLAY", the calendar is modifiable with Lightning again.

In Rainlendar's advanced options, I've already checked the option to create Mozilla compatible alerts. It would be very nice if these alerts would really be compatible. Could you please fix this?

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Has there been some changes in Lightning? I don't remember seeing this kind of problem before. The "Mozilla compatible alarms" setting just sets the acknowledge information the same way as Lightning does so you don't have to dismiss the alarms twice. The problem with the DISPLAY actions is that it doesn't support attachments which Rainlendar uses for custom sounds.
