On latest version (b139), there is a new feature add on some window of Shadow4 skin :

o Skin windows can be resized with the mouse.

So, now, if you want to resize some window of Shadow4, like: calendar/event list/todo list, you can (and must) direct use mouse to drag, by moving mouse to hover edge (right or bottom) image (must not whole transparent), then press down left-mouse and drag.
