I have had the same problem, wich is caused by the fact that you have to provide yourself with the rights to edit an installation folder.

It's quite annoying, but here's what I did to fix it:

Right click the installation folder and select properties -> security.

Then choose "Users (you\Users)" and pick allow at the topmost item; full control.
