One issue - that may not be a Rainlendar problem at all - on Kontact compatibility. Kontact does not appear to recognise recurrence added by Rainlendar (however, Rainlendar DOES recognise recurrent events added by Kontact).

This is how 1st of May recurrence would look if added by Kontact:  
RRULE:FREQ=YEARLY;INTERVAL=1;BYMONTHDAY=1;BYMONTH=5  
DTSTART;VALUE=DATE:20000501  
DTEND;VALUE=DATE:20000502

Whereas this is the same rule when applied by Rainlendar -and NOT understood by Kontact:  
RRULE:FREQ=YEARLY;INTERVAL=1  
DTSTART;VALUE=DATE:20010501  
DTEND;VALUE=DATE:20010502

This puzzles me, but I don't know the .ics format well enough to pass a judgement of who the culprit is... (As I think Sunbird reads the same recurrence format as Rainlendar, I lean towards blaming Kontact...)

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
