
Unable to load new skins

I'm trying to install the Black Panther skin and can't get it to work. Here's what I've tried so far.

First, I downloaded the .zip into the skins directory and than extracted it into the ...skins\BlackPanther2-1\Black Panther folder. That didn't work.

Second, I extracted the skin files directly into the skins folder, and that didn't work.

Checking the forums I came across this thread. So following the suggestion I refreshed RL and it still wouldn't show up. I even closed the program down and restarted it and that didn't work either.

Under Options-Skins the only available skin is Shadow4.

So my question is, what am I doing wrong and how do I load this, or any, skin? Thanks in advance for any help.

BTW, I am using v2.0 (b25).

I have the Black Panther directory that is contained in the zip file, in my rainlendar2 directory. with a refresh of the calendar it shows up in the skins listing. Though the skin shows up with a transparent background instead of black.

My location is just Black Panther, /usr/local/share/rainlendar2/skins/Black Panther/

It's directory listing is this:

You must have the Black.ini as the first thing in the subdirectory of skins. I don't know where the 2-1 folder is coming from, but it does not need to be there.

I've tried installing several skins. None of them work. Here's an excerpt from ~/.config/.rainlendar/rainlendar.log:

I unzip'd all three skins and indeed none of them have a skin.xml. I looked at the one in Shadow4 and it's obviously specific to that skin.

BTW, why do all of the skins on Customize.org have a .zip extension instead of a .r2skin extension?

Rainlendar 2 uses a new skinning format. The older skins were edited with ini files, R2 uses xml. If your going to use the old skins you must unzip(might be able to leave it as a zip) the skin in there own folder under rainlendar2/skins/. If you take the old skin and change the .zip to .r2skin it thinks it is an r2 skin and looks for the skin.xml file.
