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You can edit them in the skin file. Rename it to .zip and go to xml/elements.xml..

I'm currently looking into a way to to have "Work" only show up with the icon and not affect the color of the letters. Is this possible? Tried a couple of different aproaches but I just cant seem to find a way. Problem is, I didn't used to use any profiles, and all other events are default.

All I want is the icon in the corner for work, and then colors when another event is present.

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I just did what you what you told me to do; I opened the skin file with winrar and edited the xml/elements.xml file with word. I did this very drastically, no event has been kept unchanged, I have even renamed (translated) every name. Afterward I saved it back into the skin file.

The only result this had was that all my events turned blue with no symbols... Like some kind of default event... so it did somthing, but not what I intended...

Did I miss a step?? or do I need to edit some more files??

It concentrates mostly on category editing anyway, as that is all I ever want to do. Didn't read you latest problem. Editing with word may cause problems, but not too likely. Also when you renamed things there is a good chance you renamed things that are referenced in other XML files. If you renamed the categories then you must also edit your events to use those new names.

Coward, I know what you mean. I haven't found a way to leave the color unchanged, but what I have done is have it change the color to white, give it a lesser priority (I think) so that other events will show up on top of it. I'll grab my snippet of code.

The category names are used in your events themselves. This means that every event that had one of the old category names specified would have to be changed. If you right click the calendar and go to the manager, you can see the categories associated with your events. There is no batch renaming.

You can change it afterwards, there just is no automation that will change thing things assciated to it. If you are going to change category names there Are three places you must go.

1. The elements.xml file.
2. Each event that uses the old category name.
3. In the advanced options there is a field "DefaultCategories" That sould also be renamed.

It might be a good idea to change 3 before 2. Either way changeing one will not change the other.
