Unfortunately I am having trouble with the Google Calendar in this build.. With a dialog of "Unable to Find the Chosen Calendar" being Displayed. I know the URL is correct (In the debug log it eventually returns a 200 ok)

Please let me know if you want / need anything else to help debugging (I am on a direct Internet connection thus no proxy involved)

A further (minor) suggestion for this is that amounts divided by 1440 get shown as days (e.g. 10080 = 7 days). Why? Because the alarm setting for each has a selection bar for minutes / hours /days. If someone's going to set an alarm that's days ahead of an event, then it'd be good if the snooze option could match that.

Hello, this is my first time posting, so I should say great product - I LOVE IT! I've been playing around with this build and I ran into two problems with the Google plugin. I'm a novice so forgive me if this has already been addressed.

1) Can we sync from Rainlendar to Google? My GCal events show up in rainlendar, but when I create an event in Rainlendar, I get an error message (screenshot below). I know that Outlook is one-way sync, but does the same apply to Google? The main reason I switched to this build was to sync both ways because I don't want to have to rely on creating events in Google exclusively.
