I am having a problem that I never noticed before. On one day I have three recurring events, that occur weekly (a:9:00-10:00, b:10:00-11:00, c:14:00-15:00). On that same day I added a one-time event in google calendar that occurs from 12:00-13:00 (d). For some reason the one-time event (d) shows up last on my events list, even though it should come in between events (b) and (c).

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I'm not sure what you mean by creating sample events and attaching them. However, I just tried it again, and this problem is still occurring for me.

Event 1:

Title: Event 1

Time: 10:00 - 11:00

Repeats: Every Wednesday until December 19

Event 2:

Title: Event 2

Time: 11:00 - 12:00

Repeats: Every Wednesday until December 19

Event 3:

Title: Event 3

Time: 14:00 - 15:00

Repeats: Every Wednesday until December 19

Event 4:

Title: Event 4

Time: 13:00-14:00

Repeats: ONE TIME EVENT ONLY

I would expect Rainlendar to show:

10:00 - 11:00 - Event 1  
11:00 - 12:00 - Event 2  
13:00 - 14:00 - Event 4  
14:00 - 15:00 - Event 3

But, instead it shows:

10:00 - 11:00 - Event 1  
11:00 - 12:00 - Event 2  
14:00 - 15:00 - Event 3  
13:00 - 14:00 - Event 4

I cannot reproduce this. I created the events you described and they are shown in the correct order.

Is the Event 4 always shown last no matter what start time you set it for? What if you make some other kind of recurring events (e.g. monthly recurring)?

I did some testing, and have some strange results.

First, I should have been more specific as to the times of all the events (as it seems to make a difference!):

Event 1:  
Time: 8:30-10:30  
Repeats: Every Wednesday until December 19

Event 2:  
Time: 10:40 - 12:30  
Repeats: Every Wednesday until December 19

Event 3:  
Time: 14:40 - 16:30  
Repeats: Every Wednesday until December 19

If I set Event 4 for 4:30-5:30 it shows up in this order:

4:30 - 5:30 Event 4  
8:30 - 10:30 Event 1  
10:40 - 12:30 Event 2  
14:40 - 16:30 Event 3

If I set Event 4 for 5:30-6:30 it shows up in this order:

8:30 - 10:30 Event 1  
5:30 - 6:30 Event 4  
10:40 - 12:30 Event 2  
14:40 - 16:30 Event 3

If I set Event 4 for 7:00-8:00 it shows up in this order:

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8:30 - 10:30 Event 1  
10:40 - 12:30 Event 2  
7:00 - 8:00 Event 4  
14:40 - 16:30 Event 3

If I set Event 4 for 13:30 - 14:30 it shows up in this order:

8:30 - 10:30 Event 1  
10:40 - 12:30 Event 2  
14:40 - 16:30 Event 3  
13:30 - 14:30 Event 4

Can you try a test with those exact times and see if the problem is reproducible on your end?

The events are actually in the correct order in the tooltip that shows over the Rainlendar icon in the tray. And it is also correct when I hover over today's date in the Calendar Window. It is only in the Events window that the order is wrong.

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Yes. Just start rainlendar from command line like this:

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Rainlendar2.exe --debug
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It will enable the debugging. The log will be written to the configuration folder (C:\Documents and Settings\\rainlendar2\rainlendar2.log). Just run Rainlendar once and sent the log to me (rainy@iki.fi)

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
