I've downloaded the r2lang file from the website and tried drag and drop, but that didn't work. then I read on the forum that the .mo file needs to be copied to /usr/share/locale/de/LC\_MESSAGES in my case. But that didn't work either.

I'm clueless - I'm now using the Rainlendar 2.2 build 51 (deb package) as the 49 beta stopped working for me for no reason.
