
Plz help with Rainmeter script?

Hi Rainy, I like the look of your new site :). Sorry to post a Rainmeter question here, but I didn't know where else to go.

I've been modifying the moxa-weather config by moxamax. It's a great config, esp. since he chose to use weather.com instead of rssweather. Unfortunately, he's been inactive in customize.org for a year and hasn't answered my emails.

Everything's been going well, but I'm stuck on one value: I need to display the low temp for the current day ("today"), but I can't figure out the proper StringIndex= value. The "tomorrow" low temp value is 14, with following days being 14+11 (25, 36, etc.). however, subtracting 11 from 14 is "3", which for some reason displays the HIGH temp for "today".

Can anyone here help with this? I'd really appreciate it, cuz it's the last mod I need to do with this config to make it complete. Very frustrating!

The weather.com's xml feed doesn't contain the high and low temperatures for the current conditions. It only has the current temperature.

I don't think there is any specific tutorial for weather skins. You can quite easily find out the correct StringIndex values if you set the Debug=1 in the ini-file. It will write all the parsed strings to the debug log with the indexes. Reading about regular expressions is useful too.
