
Addons for Shadow4 skin

I created couple of examples for the Shadow4 skin. These don't exactly have anything to do with calendars so they won't be a part of the main installation but I'll release them here as an addon to show what kind of things you can do with the Rainlendar skins and lua scripts. Feel free to use the scripts in your own skins.

Note that you need Rainlendar 2.10 or newer to run these.

Here's the package: <http://www.rainlendar.net/download/Shadow4-Widgets.r2skin-addon>

To install just drop the file over the calendar window and if all goes well it should integrate itself to the default Shadow4 skin. After that you can go to the advanced skin options and choose these new windows:

RSS will show the rss feed from a given url. By default it shows the latest posts to this forum but you can define the location in the skin's settings.

Photos shows interesting images from Flickr. You can define how often the image is reloaded and if it's done randomly or not in the skin's settings. Note that this works quite poorly with copy transparency enabled.

Weather displays current conditions and the forecast for the given location.

Countdown calculates downwards to a specific date. You can set the target day and the title from the skin's settings.

TV shows current Finnish tv programs. This probably isn't very useful if don't live in Finland but I released it anyway as an example of a somewhat more complex script.

Moonphase shows the current phase of the moon.

File displays contents of a text file. The widget is automatically updated when the file changes.

Translate allows you to use Google's translate service from a desktop widget. Supports multiple languages simultaneously.

World Time displays the current time in four different places in the world. Note that you might have to adjust for the daylight saving time manually.

Search opens your favorite web search page on your browser.

Localization:

If you want to help with the localization here is the psd template for the background texts:

The font that is used in the texts is called Fusi which you probably can find from the internet quite easily. You can send the translated images to me (rainy@iki.fi) in png format so I can add them to the addon. Or you can just tell what the translations are and I'll create the images.

That's great, especially the weather script.

I tried to edit the script weather.lua for other language feeds from weather.msn.com but failed miserably for the tooltip :(Could you help me what I'm doing wrong?

Steps I did:

Feed: <http://wetter.msn.com/RSS.aspx?wealocations=wc:AUX0025&weadegreetype=C&culture=de-DE>

the last part &culture=de-DE makes it a German feed and then the tooltip part of the script fails and only shows "Wien".

I tried to edit the lua script and did the following in it:

With this I still can't get it to correctly draw the tooltip. It still only shows me "Wien" (the title).

To be sure I just compared it again and this is the only difference to the original script.

On second view it seems that this part of the script is not actually used in Rainlendar but taken from a hardcoded part? Or something else I'm doing wrong because with the changed script from above I get the correct english tooltip when I delete the "&culture=de-DE" from the link.

Edit: another instance I fail is when I try to make the forecast temperatures show by editing Lo: Hi: to Niedrig: Höchst:

The addons do not change the same files so it should be possible (I just tried it and did not get any errors). You need to make sure that you don't apply the same addon twice to the skin because it can corrupt it. If you cannot get it to work could you check from the Rainlendar's debug log what is the exact error it gives?

ok, found the very strange reason why it didn't work.

Before editing the shadow4 skin directly I tried the script in my skin. Of course it didn't work correctly since the call for the script in weather.xml goes out to the shadow4 skin lua file (I only noticed that later). So I removed the not working "calendar" in the skin settings from the active calendars and added the shadow4 weather calendar.

But for some strange reason Rainlendar still used the weather.lua from my skin. So no matter what I changed, it always used the wrong weather.lua file. Very strange why Rainlendar would do that and I'm very annoyed that I spent two hours or so figuring out what goes wrong in the script only to find that Rainlendar used the wrong one :)

Maybe the log needs to track down the path of the script used from skins, too.

Also it is strange that even though I changed the url of the Shadow4 Weather skin but it used the wrong lua file....

SORRY, my fault.

Firefox renamed the Skin file to Shadow4.r2skin-addon(2).

Rainlendar does not know a skin with this name. Renaming the file solved the problem. Everything works as expected now.

The scripts are always global. This means that if two script files have a function with the same name the one which is loaded later will overwrite the first one (or so I suspect; I haven't actually tried this). So, when modifying the scripts the function names should be changed too (that's the reason why they are usually prefixed with the skin name). Also note that the scripts are always loaded if you are using at least one window from the given skin even if that window wouldn't use any of the scripts.

It might be useful (and probably more logical too) to limit the scripts only for the skin where they are defined but it would require a rewrite of all the scripting related code.

The widget addon has been updated. It now uses the same method to download stuff as the network shared calendars so proxies are supported now too. I also added couple of new widgets to the addon. You need to have build 59 or newer.

If you want to use e.g. the weather window in some other skin you need to copy the weather.xml and weather.lua files to the skin. The xml file defines the outlook of the window so you need to edit it to use different graphics and such. In the lua script you should replace all "Shadow4" texts to the name of the other skin (don't use spaces in the skin name).

Naughty, are you behind a proxy server? If you are, make sure that you use the latest Rainlendar build (b60) and the latest version of the skin addon. If that doesn't help, please attach the Rainlendar's debug log (see the link in my previous post).

There are no separate licenses for the beta so if you want to use the Pro features you need the same license file as with the current stable version.

P.S: I've got a localization bug. If you use the rss to the german msn weather url in rainlendar, you get a character bug at the tooltip. It appears that it can't display the "ä", "ö" and "ü" chars. Its strange that in the line under the buggy one the "ü" char appears correct (see: "Gefühlte Temp."). Down below is a picture: and my msn weather rss link, if that helps.

Hello mpatterson1,

I never used a Mac, but if you want to test my files, maybe this can help you.

In Windows, when we have installed Rainlendar and the Shadow4-Widgets.r2skin-addon, we can find the Shadow4 skin (Shadow4.r2skin) in the ~/.rainlendar2/skins folder. We can make a copy of it, that we rename Shadow4Mod.zip (for example). In this way, we can unzip it.

This gives a folder in which are all the files of the skin. It contains a subfolder named 'images', another named 'scripts' and a last 'xml'.

In my files, the 'weather.lua' must be moved in the 'script' folder, 'weather.xml' in 'xml', and 'weather-bg-English.png' in 'images'.

Now, we can find this modified version of Shadow4 (named Shadow4Mod) in the Options of Rainlendar. It is considered as a new skin.

It allows to display a desired month in Rainlendar. I think this feature can be useful, but I had not found it so far, while the "Rainlendar_SetDisplayDate ()" exists.

A month can be selected by its number or its name. The widget works in all languages. There are some error checks, but it can miss some tests (especially for years). The appearance must be corrected. I used the icons of the Chromophore skin (to go to the current month, previous and next).

Rainy, I had not been able to find a metter to put the focus to a field. I would like the focus is placed directly over the year after the month validation.

Moreover, would it be possible to automatically translate the "InfoText" in the "edit" tag as the "text" in the "text" tag ? I don't know how to create an add-on, so the file below contains a directory "Shadow4-Goto-Modified" containing the modified files, and a folder "Shadow4-Goto-complete" containing a complete skin, in order to try.

Hey Rainy,

Just wanted to let you know that I love Rainlendar and have been using it for quite some time. I also wanted you to know that I just updated to the latest 2.6 build (for some reason I missed 2.5) and have a few suggestions for you. Actually, I have fewer suggestions than I thought I was going to have because several of the suggestions I had, you already incorporated into v2.6! So here are my suggestions:

I would like to see a few more 'data cleanup' commands added to the rss.lua file. In particular I think it would be nice to have:

s = string.gsub(s, "â„ç", "™")

This is based entirely on the need with the RSS feeds I actually read with Rainlendar. I am sure there are more that could be added.

The second item is that I think it would be nice if you could select different weather icons from within the Weather options menu. I understand that this would involve you adding more icon packs to the program and thus increase the file size, but it would be cosmetically pleasing. One particular icon set I have found that works quite nicely is Weather Icons Shiny by ~JyriK found at:

The third and final item is I noticed that you added a Moonphase widget which I think is pretty nice. Your setup looks very similar to the one from Vitrum by Alex Sivets.
